These designations tie directly into Value-Based Reimbursement (VBR) performance. Highlights of this cycle include:

- **CQ VBR:** 35 practices were recognized for performing at a high level in quality across BCBSM commercial and Medicare Advantage plans, placing them among the top performers in Michigan!
- **NDoH VBR:** 19 practices were recognized for engaging patients in screening for Non-Medical Drivers of Health, formerly Social Determinants of Health (SDoH), and connecting them with essential community resources, demonstrating leadership in addressing whole-person health.
- **PDCM VBR:** 82 practices were recognized for providing patient-delivered care management services, ensuring patients with complex needs receive the support coordination they deserve.
- **MAT VBR:** 10 practices were recognized for supporting patients with substance use disorder through evidence-based medication-assisted treatment, playing a vital role in combating the ongoing opioid epidemic.
- **MCT2D VBR:** 21 practices were recognized for strong engagement in collaborative diabetes initiatives, helping improve outcomes for patients living with and managing Type 2 diabetes across Michigan.
